## 摘要

本文試圖探索的即是1945年以後二十多年間國民政府對台的空間政治，台灣的空间如何根據意識形態被形塑、作用和分配？探討台灣光復後空間「去日本化、再中國化」的實施綱領和具體實踐，五〇年代與六〇年代空間景觀的變化等等。研究範疇將包含實體和象徵性空間，綜合起來勾勒出戰後主導勢力如何從外在空間的改造，進行內在空間的支配佔用。在現代化、中國化的文化語境下，他們的再現空間又如何與台灣實際的空間實踐接軌？

### Abstract

This project intends to explore the literary representation of the changing spaces by newly immigrant and native writers after 1945. Under the stressful spatial politics, while Taiwan was going through reconstructed, functioned and distributed. how were the place, town, countryside and natural environment conceived and portrayed? This project deals with the postwar politics of representations of space, exploring the “de-Japanesized and resinicized” policies and practices, and the transformation of landscapes from 50s to 60s. The research areas include real and symbolic spaces, in order to explain how the dominant power tried to manipulate residents’ inner space via the reformation of public landscapes.
